We also want to hear from you. There will be ample opportunity for the community to ask questions, give feedback and engage in this discussion. All are welcome to attend. We hope to see you there as Lafourche Parish continues to move forward in a strong recovery.

Items for Discussion at the meeting:

1. What happened to cause the flood.
2. What NLLD was working on prior to Hurricane Ida and what impact that might have had if it were complete.
3. What we have in planning as a secondary defense in the area and when that might come about.
4. Morganza to the Gulf status and funding.
5. National Flood Insurance and new insurance rates with Risk Rating 2.0
6. Long term Housing
7. Mud/debris pickup
